Your health is our top concern. We understand that the prescription drugs you need to manage your health can be costly. You can feel confident choosing a generic drug:

- Generic drugs are becoming the choice among doctors and patients—more than 65 percent of prescriptions filled today are for generic drugs, and that percentage is growing.¹
- The U.S. Food and Drug Administration requires that generic drugs meet the same quality standards as brand-name drugs.
- Brand-name drugs cost an average six times more than generic drugs¹—yet generics are just as safe and effective.

Your next steps:

- 1. Ask your doctor to prescribe a generic drug before your next refill. Your doctor is most qualified to balance drug cost and quality considerations.
- 2. If your doctor doesn't think a generic option is right for you, ask your doctor to prescribe a preferred select[†] brand drug listed on the back side of this letter, which may cost you less than other brand-name drugs.
- 3. Fill your prescription through a pharmacy in the CVS Caremark network (find one at www.caremark.com) as you generally will pay less than using a pharmacy outside the network.
